1.	Update from rektor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New teachers – challenging to secure replacement teacher capacity. Secured 5 new teachers to date (June '23) and hoping to secure 2 more.</li> <li>• Kommune's school food initiative – school is proposing to have breakfast offer rather than lunch based on experience that kids generally have suitable lunch with them but many arrive at school hungry. Aim for an option to have breakfast available 3 days a week. Would require 20% position to operationalise.</li> <li>• Gym ventilation – this is an ongoing discussion with commune. Maintenance check scheduled mid June.</li> <li>• Lervig skole – current plan is that this will open in 2025. Pupils from Nylund school will be the first to be placed in Lervig. Expectation that there will be a reduced school catchment area from autumn 2025. Majority of current pupils are expected to continue through the school.</li> <li>• 7<sup>th</sup> grade leaving dinner – plan is that the teachers will take over running this event from next year.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•</li> </ul>
2.	Way forward with FAU	<p>Discussion around focus areas for FAU going forward. Key points were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Info / communication with the school. Important to be more proactive and document expectations.</li> <li>• Viglo – how is this digital tool used?</li> <li>• Write-up status on recurring themes e.g. condition of gym and cleaning of toilets.</li> <li>• How many events should FAU organize?</li> </ul>	

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clarify that fund raising events are split between FAU and Korps as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 17<sup>th</sup> May – korps (FAU activities free for kids).</li> <li>○ Christmas tree event – FAU (source of funding for 17<sup>th</sup> May activities).</li> </ul> </li> <li>• 7<sup>th</sup> grade trip – to be organized by parents. Add to årshjul and ensure class contact is clear of expectations.</li> <li>• 17<sup>th</sup> May organization, continue with model where 6<sup>th</sup> grade parents help run the event. Consider split of responsibility between FAU and 6<sup>th</sup> grade parents.</li> </ul>	
3.	AOB	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Should Chrome books be allowed home over the summer break? Suggestion that where relevant discussion in class, the parents should vote in Spond on their preference. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check is school is able to store Chrome books during summer break.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
